Thank you to all those who attended Sefton's Economic Forum (SEF) – Expanding Your Markets - on Wednesday 29th April 2015.

Held in partnership with Liverpool & Sefton Chambers of Commerce and supported by **Bibby Financial Services** the SEF was hosted by Jenny Stewart, CEO of Liverpool & Sefton Chambers of Commerce, with a keynote speech from Sefton Council's CEO, Margaret Carney outlining developments within Sefton over the next five years and how Sefton is changing.

Over 100 businesses attended the event, with speakers providing insight on how to win new customers, improve business potential to penetrate, develop and expand markets, as well product development and diversification and how exporting can play a big part.

A wide breadth of speakers from Influential, University of Liverpool, Liverpool and Sefton Chamber of Commerce, UKTI, Sefton@Work, The Hub (apprenticeships), InvestSefton, and local business owner Matt Byron, 4040 Media, who talked about his journey to success, ensured that several aspects were covered and reviewed from different angles.

Invest Sefton launched the new Sefton Exporters Network and **www.exportsefton.com** and informed companies about the opportunity of a 35% grant towards the cost of professional services through the **New Markets programme**.

Nexus Planning introduced objectives and outlined early thoughts for Southport Development Strategy, giving attendees the opportunity to find out more about shaping a Vision for Southport.

Businesses also had the opportunity to meet and talk to potential apprentices available for work.
