Sefton MBC is currently leading this project to provide a high quality watersports facility adjacent to Crosby Marine Lake.

The scheme now nearing completion is part of the wider regeneration will provide conference and teaching facilities, specialist accommodation, fitness facilities and a restaurant and bar. The emphasis at the new centre, which will form part of the Greenbank Sports Academy is on outdoor water sports including canoeing and rowing, wind surfing, sailing and yachting.



The two storey timber and steel frame building is a contemporary design accredited to BREEAM Very Good and includes a Turf Roof and other environmental features.

Building work which began on this £8.3 Million development in May 2008 with the facility scheduled to open in the summer.
