

The road to recovery





- Pre-pandemic 5.1m passengers in 2019
- Full recovery expected in 2024
- Forecast to exceed highest ever annual passenger throughput in 2025



Jet2 to operate from LJLA – the most significant development at the airport in over 20 years

- Jet2.com and Jet2holidays announce Liverpool to be their newest base, launching flights and holidays for Summer 2024
- 20 destinations on sale, with flights commencing on 28th March 2024
- Includes 7 new destinations from Liverpool
- Up to 54 weekly flights, including 12 flights to both the Canary Islands and the Balearic Islands every week
- 565,000 seats on sale
- Over 200 jobs to be created
- Brings together Which? Recommended Travel Brand and Which? recommended UK Airport
- Winter '24/'25 and Summer '25 now on sale too!









Greater global connectivity

- Aer Lingus commenced 11 flights per week to Dublin in April 2023, with onward connections to their US network
- US Preclearance facility at Dublin Airport, arriving in the US effectively as a domestic passenger
- Lufthansa route to Frankfurt launched in May 2022, with connections to over 150 global destinations
- Flights subsequently increased from 3 to 6 weekly departures from Summer 2023

Changes to security procedures





- £3.5m investment in enhanced security equipment for screening of passengers and hand luggage to be in place at all UK airports with more than 1m passengers per year, by June 2024
- 6 new x-ray machines + 3 additional body scanners
- Passengers can leave electrical items such as tablets, laptops and liquids (up to 2 litres) in their cabin baggage
- In place by March 2024 to be ready for busy summer ahead
- Body scanners to be used for all passengers



Caring about the future

- Recently published our Decarbonisation Plan, setting out our route to decarbonisation by 2040
- 14 acre solar farm to be built generating 22% of the airport's electricity needs
- Soon to launch our first ESG Report, aligning with 4 UN Sustainable Development Goals
